

Eden Township Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes
January 31, 2011 @ 8:00 p.m.

This meeting was called to order in the Eden Community Center by Chairman Don Glover, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. The following Eden Township personnel were also present; Trustee Ken Hall, Trustee Ryan Bagent and Fiscal Officer Steve Little. Eden Township residents and former Eden Township Trustee Shani Smith-Reed and her husband Brian Reed and Licking County Sheriff Deputy Nick Pease were also present. Road Maintenance Supervisor Dan Baker came in later. A copy of the minutes, a monthly cash journal report and; fund, appropriation and revenue status reports were given all trustees. Trustee Hall moved to waive the reading of the minutes, Trustee Bagent seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The minutes were filed for the permanent record.

Public Participation: Deputy Pease spoke of starting a “Neighborhood Block Watch” in response to the recent breaking and entering and burglaries in the township. Shani and Brian, whose home was one of the homes broken into were interested in ways to prevent this type thing for themselves and others in the township in the future. It was agreed to discuss the Block watch concept and discuss it at the next regular meeting of the Eden Township Board of Trustees.

Old Business: The lights on the Eden Community Center have been converted to being on all night in an effort to deter pack activity after dark. The generator that was installed to keep the fireband repeater up and running at all times has been installed and tested. Installation is complete.

New Business: Comments were made that night–time traffic around the Community Center has already been reduced since the change in lighting. Trustee Bagent moved to place, “Park Closes at Dark” signs around the Community Center. Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all members voted aye.

Trustee Bagent moved to pay the bills, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The attached listing is a true and accurate listing of the bills that were presented to be paid.

Trustee Hall made a motion to adjourn, Trustee Bagent seconded the motion and all trustees voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
