This meeting was called to order in the Eden Community Center by Chairman Ryan Bagent, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. The following Eden Township personnel were also present; Trustee Ken Hall, Trustee Don Glover and Fiscal Officer Steve Little. A copy of the minutes, a monthly cash journal report and; fund, appropriation and revenue status reports were given all trustees. Trustee Glover moved to waive the reading of the minutes, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The minutes were filed for the permanent record.

## **<u>Public Participation:</u>** There was none.

**<u>Old Business:</u>** It was reported we were still working on the accommodations for the Sheriff's Sub-station. Progress is being made but not as quickly as originally hoped. The fire band radio was installed. The Licking County Child Support Agency will advertise their desks and file cabinets on Gov Deals April 1, 2012. The quality is good and the price should be reasonable. The keys are in the office to distribute to the Sheriff as soon as the room is ready.

<u>New Business:</u> Trustee Glover reported that Jon Goldsberry had contacted him regarding a dispute with the Smith's. A letter had been received from the Smith's. the letter was read and placed in the permanent "communication received" file. It was decided to ask the Licking County Prosecutor's office for advice regarding the dispute.

There was considerable discussion regarding the most recent failure of our proposed fire levy. It was decided by a motion from trustee Glover and seconded by trustee hall to place a 3.5 mill continuing levy on the ballot in the August Special Election. This was done in spite of the fact the cost may be as high as \$8000. The trustees agree by unanimous decision the need was too great to wait and all vote aye.

It was agreed to contact the Health Department regarding the conditions at the Magers property on Stradley Road.

**<u>Road Report:</u>** Road Maintenance Supervisor, Dan Baker reported it has been as good winter so far but the roads are starting to break up and asphalt grindings will be needed to repair them as that seemed to work well last year. The Trustees all agreed.

Trustee Glover moved to pay the bills, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The attached listing is a true and accurate listing of the bills that were presented to be paid.

Trustee Hall made a motion to adjourn, Trustee Glover seconded the motion and all trustees voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
