

Eden Township Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes  
June 25, 2012 @ 8:00 p.m.

This meeting was called to order in the Eden Community Center by Ken Hall, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. The following Eden Township personnel were also present; Trustee Don Glover and Fiscal Officer Steve Little. Eden Township/Stradley Road Resident Jon Goldsberry was also in attendance. Road Maintenance Supervisor Ban Baker came in later. A copy of the minutes, a monthly cash journal report and; fund, appropriation and revenue status reports were given all trustees. Trustee Glover moved to waive the reading of the minutes, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The minutes were filed for the permanent record.

**Public Participation:** Jon Goldsberry explained his problem with a fence line between his property and the property of Wayne and Patti Smith. He had a copy of an old drawing and talked about an old agreement between the parties. At this time he wanted the law to be applied and would like to move forward with his complaint. He was advised that the Board of Trustees were working with the Licking County Prosecutor and that the Board would work towards resolution. Mr. Goldsberry expressed his disappointment with the time it was taking and he took exception with the “equitable” part of the language in the resolution process that had been outlined for him. He further advised the Smith’s “were not gonna walk over me no more” and that they shouldn’t assume he was going to take care of their problem livestock.

**Old Business:** It was reported we were still working on the accommodations for the Sheriff’s Sub-station. Progress is still being made but not as quickly as originally hoped. The air conditioning unit has been purchased from Herald’s in Mt. Vernon and Trustee Bagent was going to arrange for installation as soon as possible upon his return.

**New Business:** There was no new business.

**Road Report:** Road Maintenance Supervisor, Dan Baker reported the roads would need additional asphalt grindings and that paving will start in August. Dan advised he would be on vacation for two (2) weeks in September. He also advised that we could use a 1000 – 2000 gallon poly tank for salt water storage. All advise they would try to locate on.

Trustee Glover moved to pay the bills, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The attached listing is a true and accurate listing of the bills that were presented to be paid.

Trustee Glover made a motion to adjourn, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all trustees voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
