This meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm, by Chairman Ken Hall, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. In addition to Mr. Hall the following Eden Township personnel were present; Trustee Dave Baker, Trustee Chuck Dunlap, Fiscal Officer Robin McKee, Mike Baker Road Supervisor and Eden Township citizens Harry Farley, and Kyle Broceus, David McKee and speaker-Alan Doup with Co-Alliance. A copy of previous months minutes, bank reconcile, monthly cash journal, fund status, and revenue status was given to the trustees.

Trustee Baker moved to waive the reading and approved the minutes from the June 29th meeting. Trustee Dunlap seconded the motion.

## Public Participation:

1. Alan Doup introduced himself to the Board and the attending citizens. He wanted to provide information on his services for fuel and propane and give estimated pricing for the township. Rustee Baker asked if we are allowed to run off-road fuel in the equipment and Mr Doup answered yes. Mr. Doup also noted that they would be willing to provide a 300 gallon tank and pump for the township so that the township can purchase off-road fuel for the equipment to save the tax dollars spent on on-road fuel they are currently using. He could also set a new tank at the township hall for propane and is willing to give the township a locked in price for the 2020/2021 winter months.

# Old Business:

- 1. CD Interest- Fiscal Officer McKee presented the Board with the division of interest for the CD that was previously found and had not been entered into UAN for approval.
  - General Fund 16.055% (\$1387.58)
  - Motor Vehicle Fund 6.707% (\$579.66)
  - Gas Fund 25.406% (\$2195.77)
  - Road & Bridge Fund 25.563% (\$2209.34)
  - Fire Fund 22.992% (\$1987.14)

- Cemetery Fund 3.277% (\$283.23)

Interest will be entered in UAN and accounted for by the August meeting.

- 2. Stradley Road project was discussed and tabled since MaryAnn Township has notified the township that the Stickle Road project is a go. Trustee Baker will reach out to Mid-Ohio and see what the cost would be to only chip & seal the paved areas from 2019 and to only pulverized Stradley Road this year and wait for Chip & Seal of Stradley until next year.
- 3. Trustee Baker reported the new tires have been put on the equipment, the tractor has been fixed and the DEF filter had needed changed and the mower pulley is now fixed.

#### New Business:

1. Trustee Hall read a letter he received for the township from Raymond Selden Walton on Camp Ohio Road "letter attached". Mr. Walton is requesting that the speed limit be changed from 55mph to 45mph. Trustee Baker will contact the Engineers office to see if they will do an estimate to change the speed limit.

Trustee Hall moved a motion to contact the Engineers office on behalf of Mr Walton, Trustee Dunlap seconded the motion.

2. Fiscal Officer McKee reported that The Department of Agriculture had left a message wanting to speak with someone about the spraying of pesticides in the township. Trustee Hall believes that it is the electric company that is dong the spraying. Trustee Baker will call Mr Walker with Energy Co-op to see who is contracted to do the spraying for the township and will contact The Department of Agriculture to let them know the township is not doing any spraying.

## Road Report:

- Rocky Fork culvert has been cleaned out and is in need of new double wall 40' x 12" and may need to be raised on the camp side a little.
- The ditch on Graceland has been fixed.
- Bero has ordered the material to fix the loader bucket.
- We need to order 411 limestone.

Trustee Baker move a motion to pay bills. Trustee Hall seconded the motion.
