This meeting was called to order in the Eden Community Center by Chairman Ryan Bagent, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. New Business: Oxford Oil has requested to cross Oldaker Road by boring underground. The request for the permit was signed by all trustees. A special meeting was set for 6:00 a.m on August 8, 2012, the day after the special election to review the outcome and to possibly place the fire levy back on the ballot in November if it failed. Notice will be sent to the Newark Advocate as required.

<u>Road Report:</u> Road Maintenance Supervisor, Dan Baker reported the roads would need additional asphalt grindings and that paving didn't start in August due to the June 29 storm. He has been patching and clearing brush from the derecho storm that damaged the block building by the store. He has been working to complete the brush clearing in time to meet with FEMA Representatives on August 3, 2012. The hope is to get disaster money to pay for some clean up. Dan advised again that he would be on vacation for two (2) weeks in September.

Trustee Glover moved to pay the bills, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The attached listing is a true and accurate listing of the bills that were presented to be paid.

Trustee Glover made a motion to adjourn, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all trustees voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
