

# Eden Township Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes

August 29, 2016 - 8:00 p.m.

This meeting was called to order in the Eden Community Center by Chairman Don Glover, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. In addition to Mr. Glover, the following Eden Township personnel were present; Trustee Ken Hall, Trustee Ryan Bagent, Fiscal Officer Steve Little, and Road Maintenance Supervisor Robert Nethers. Several township residents were also present. A copy of the minutes, a monthly cash journal report and; fund, appropriation and revenue status reports were given to the trustees. Trustee Hall moved to waive the reading of the minutes, Trustee Bagent seconded the motion all voted in favor, and the minutes were filed for the permanent record.

**Public Participation:** Several residents commented on road conditions and the decision to return some roads to gravel, primarily Oldaker Road and Graceland Lane residents, (see attached attendance sheet) were upset about the dirt roads. Resident Chuck Dunlap challenged where the money was being spent and additional questions were raised about future plans to pave. The Issue 2 grant application was discussed and residents were told that we were unsuccessful with the most recent application, and that the trustees planned on applying again in the future.

**Old Business:** The 48” culvert on Baker Road North is done, Dave Baker has the culvert he asked the township to install he just has to get it home so we can install it on Oldaker Road

**New Business:** Trustee Bagent asked about a mirror on a pole at the Tarlton Road and Eden Church Road intersection, he will check with LRE for permission to mount it on a pole there.

**Road Report:** A safety issue was raised regarding the vehicles parked in front of the Samantha Magers property. Fiscal Officer Little will check on the process for removing those vehicles with the prosecutor.

Trustee Bagent moved to pay the bills, Trustee Hall seconded the motion and all voted in favor. The attached listing is a true and accurate listing of the bills that were presented to be paid.

Trustee Hall moved to approve the purchase of up to \$2000 for tools in the garage, Trustee Bagent seconded the motion and all voted in favor.

Trustee Hall made a motion to adjourn, Trustee Bagent seconded the motion and all Trustees voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
