Trustee Hall moved to place the old Ford tractor on Gov Deals. Trustee Glover seconded the motion and all trustees voted in favor.

New Business:

Trustee Glover reported the Sterling dump truck was back in service but it still had a problem. It was agreed unanimously to get it fixed. Don also reported the road grader would need tires. It was agreed to get a price.

Trustee Bagent commented that something had to be done on Blacksnake Road at the bottom of the hill. All trustees agreed and Smalls Asphalt Paving will be contacted to get it fixed. There was discussion on the proposed Waste Management Contract Extension. All agreed to discuss it at the next meeting.

Road Report:
