It was acknowledged that Road Maintenance Supervisor Dan Baker had worked hard to maintain the paved and chip and seal roads with the money that has been was available

Abe Miller, the Amish builder has started replacing and sealing around the windows in the Eden Community Center. With cost estimates being below \$5000 the repair of the windows is a much needed improvement due to water leaking into the building.

New Business:

Discussion regarding the cost of Dan Baker's hospitalization insurance was debated. All trustees will think about this issue and it was tabled until a future meeting.

Road Report:

Road Maintenance Supervisor, Dan Baker reported they are still patching.
