This meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Chairman Chuck Dunlap, with all present standing to recite the pledge of allegiance. Public Participation:

Raymie Carr presented the Trustees with a price sheet for the mowing, including prices totaling \$405.00 per weekly mowing for the township house, maintenance building and all cemeteries. They have switch some of the truck to front load for the safety of their employees.

Old Business:

Elliott Heating and Cooling still had not contacted Fiscal Officer McKee about the check from August not yet being cashed. Trustee Baker said he would stop by their office and see what he could find out.

The BWC audit went well.

The grader is currently at a \$350.00 charge and Gary is still trying to get it apart.

After looking over Engineer estimates for possible 2023 road work the trustees have decided to go with Baker Road North from the County line to just north of Billman Road and 550' off Baker Road onto Camp Ohio Road. Fiscal Officer McKee will contact the prosecutor's office to get a bid packet put together for the trustees to look over for the April meeting.

New Business:

Fiscal Officer McKee asked if the trustees would like for the porta-john to be brought back for the summer/fall. The trustees agreed and Robin said she would call and schedule it to be brought.

The tailgate on the F550 has been fixed to accommodate the use of the durapatcher.

Trustee Dunlap moved motion to pay from the ARP fund the 7 days of lost work for Mike during his time off after testing positive for Covid. Robin will contact Amy to see if we are allowed to use ARP funds to pay for that time.
