Notice is hereby given that Eden Township is seeking to fill an open position for the full-time road maintenance worker.

Job Summary—Appointed by the Board of Trustees to perform physical labor aimed at maintaining and repairing roads; cleaning and digging ditches; removing snow, ice and debris from roadways; maintaining the township facilities, buildings, playground and cemeteries.

Qualifications—Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, must possess and maintain a valid driver's license; must have a clean driving record; must have prior experience in maintenance work; must have working knowledge of the operation, maintenance and repair of trucks, tractors and equipment; must be able to perform physical labor for long periods of time; must be able to work in adverse weather conditions; must be on-call for emergency situation (i.e. snow and ice control, debris removal, cemetery duties); must be able to follow directions; must be able to communicate politely with the public.

Applicants will be required to pass a pre-employment and random drug screens.

Wages will be based on experience.
