<u>Public Participation:</u>

Mr. Felumlee asked why gas and electric aggregation was on the ballot for Eden Twp.

Trustee Baker explained that we are exempt, this does not apply to those who are customers of the co-op.

Mr. Felumlee then asked why is it on our ballot then.

Trustee Baker explained he was told that since we are part of Licking County we have a right to vote on issue even though it will not apply to us.

Mr. Felumlee asked if the mowing has been completed for the year.

Trustee Dunlap said Mike still has 6 roads to complete.

Mr. Felumlee asked if Stradley Rd was one of the 6 because the areas that he cannot mow along the road had not yet been touched.

Trustee Baker said that Stradley Rd was one of the 6 that are still to come.

Old Business:

Rescue Plan money needs to be spent.

Trustee Baker said that the township is in need of a truck and/or backhoe.

The backhoe we have is still having issues with the front bucket, it is now flopping over and killing the ignition when using the small bucket.

Trustee Baker said he had found a 2015 backhoe for \$60,000.00 with only 1676 hours. We could see what they would give us for ours to trade in.

Trustee Baker moved motion not to exceed \$60,000.00 for the purchase of a used backhoe Trustee Dunlap seconded the motion.

He has had no luck finding another used truck for brine application in the summer months.

Bodle Rd was completed as per Mr. Sapps request last month. Asphalt grindings were applied by the help of Trustee Baker with his dump truck (at no charge) they also used the dura patcher.

Mr. Farley asked if the port-a-john had been removed.

Fiscal Officer McKee said she had called and had them remove it after last months meeting.

New Business:

3rd Qtr unemployment reports have been filed.

Fiscal Officer McKee received a letter from Mr. Snedden requesting infomaton why the township had paid OPWC. She sent him the information on the payment requested explaining he mistook OPERS for OPWC. The township has not paid OPWC.

The mail service in our area has become questionable, the credit card statement and the bill from the City of Newark for emulsion has not yet been delivered.

Fiscal Officer McKee asked that the board move motion for her to be able to pay both once received outside of normal bill pay.

Trustee Dunlap moved to allow the bills to be paid once received. Trustee Laughman seconded the motion.
