Public Discussion

Dave McKee asked Chuck if he went to the house and told Robin to keep her mouth shut. Chuck who was delivering papers to Robin. He did not stop just to talk to her. Chuck asked Robin if there was an issue to discuss with the guys and not in front of everyone at the meeting. It makes us (twp0) look bad. Dave McKee said he will pull his home security tapes. Robin argues there is no team, she thinks it is just Chuck in charge. Chuck said all discussions are open, there are no special meetings.
